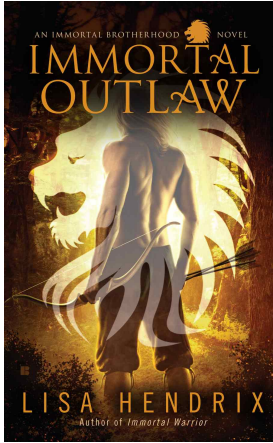


IMMORTAL OUTLAW

- 4) Cwen, the sorceress, is out for destruction. What are her motives? Do you think she will win in the end?
- 5) What did you think of the quest Robin and Marian were sent on? Was it a fair test for Robin? Do you think Robin's father would have been satisfied that Robin proved himself worthy in the end?
- 6) If you've read IMMORTAL WARRIOR, what has interested you most in this series so far?
- 7) What aspects of immortality do you find interesting? Would you want to be immortal? Why or why not? What kind of sacrifices would be most difficult? What does a belief in immortality say about a person or culture?
- 8) Did having a book with connections to Robin Hood made you more likely to read it?
- 9) Name other romances based on legends, myth, or classic books. How does bringing classic tales into new novels create interest for the reader?
- 10) What is it about the tale of Robin Hood that has given such longevity to the character for so many generation?
